Bitterness



'See to it that no one misses the grace of God and no bitter root grows up to cause trouble and defile many..."Hebrews 12:15-17 NIV

Bitterness is like a cancer eats up the host. It can damage the body of Christ and cut us off from the Grace of God. We must get rid of all bitterness, rage and anger, brawling and slander, along with every form of malice (Eph 4:31.)

The following examples can lead us to understand how easy it is if we lack caution to fall into the trap of bitterness, and if we lack repentance to miss God's blessings.

Ruth 1:20-21 tells us after Naomi lost her husband and two sons respectively, she became self-pity and lost her mind because she started complaining, blaming God for her misfortune. She even made it public and told her people to call her 'Mara," meaning 'bitterness."

Hebrews 12:16-17 explains

how Esau compromised his faith by trading his spiritual birthright for a single meal -- a temporary ease. Though he regretted his loss, since he did not repent, he lost salvation from God.

It is like today when storms sweep over us or circumstances encounter us, if we do not stand still in faith and fear not, our faith will slide back quickly. Neither repentance nor awareness will deprive us of God's blessing, which entraps us into bitterness and godlessness.

The Bible says 'Offence would come, but we have to repent it before it destroys you, for bitterness breeds hatred in us." We must guard ourselves from the attack of enemy. 1 Peter 5:8 exhorts us "Be self-controlled and alert. Your enemy the devil

prowls around **like** a roaring lion looking for someone to devour."

As we walk in the will of God, the enemy would try to break us into pieces. So brethren do not give the enemy any opportunity to devour us by planting even a tiny bitter root in our minds.

Let us resist him with love and stand firm in the faith, and remember God's love never fails.

Bitterness imprisons life but love releases bitterness: bit-

love releases bitterness; bitterness paralyzes life but love empowers it.

We are one family in Christ Jesus, no matter of our nationalities or skin colors, and we must Walk in LOVE and Walk into the UNITY, and see no one misses the grace of God and no heart is troubled by bitterness. If one suffers, so does the rest.

a cancer on the food passage from the mouth to the stomach. His physician could do nothing with it and his health condition was deteriorating, said Amano.

When Amano came to learn Kusu was ill with this fatal disease, he felt sad.

The Holy Spirit revealed to Amano 'Nothing is impossible with God' so the whole congregation started praying for the pastor.

Soon the miracle of God started working and Kusu was 'instantly' restored to health, said Amano. Kusu told his physician at the hospital he had no

cancer and demanded a health check but this

irritated his physician for he could not believe it. However throughout all necessary examinations of Kusu's health, the physician surprisingly found there was no sign or symptom of the cancer in Kusu.

Kusu also glorified God with his testimony on TV, and immediately this great news spread over the island, where the local people brought the sick to the church and received healing resulted from God.

Amano's family is also another fabulous work of God and he would like to share it with us. About ten years ago after his stepbrother receiving a position as a medical doctor at the Chiba Univer-

sity Hospital 'suddenly' co mmitted suicide, puzzling everyone and breaking his mother's heart. His mother became mentally ill.

On a certain day, his older sister brought the Bible to his mother and the scriptures in John 9:3 "Neither this man or his pa rents sinned," said Jesus, 'but this happened so that the work of God might be displayed in his life" which healed the mother instantly. Amano concludes with Jer 32:37 "I am the Lord, the God of all mankind. Is anything too hard for me?"

As darkness has covered over Japan's economy since the economic bubble in 1992, 'many others' are filled with fear they may be one of the scapegoats, and completely lack confidence in the nation's economy revival. "I feel secured and confident in my finance after I have brought the tithe to the House of God," said Kameyama, who was raised in a Christian family but

Four months later from then the very first time they received the knowledge of tithing from a testimony presented by a ten-year-old girl who received more allowance from her grandmother after she brought one tenth out of the allowance to the altar. This testimony tugged into their hearts, and though the husband had debt at that time they chose to obey.

Aug. 2003 he started working at Mitsubishi Estate Company Ltd's Group, the bi ggest real estate enterprise in Japan, as a position of leadership with a salary more than twice as much as he had made at his former company. Besides. Wednesday and Sunday Messages from Japanese Service help him tackle the problems at his workplace. Their housing rent decreased. His toothache is healed and so on ...

Brethren, let us be a cheerful giver, an enthusiastic giver, and start expecting financial blessings from God.

2001 at a time she had an accident occurred at her former company, an onand-off work, so to speak, because of the gloomy economy in Japan. That incident had set her hospitalized about 20 days and stayed home for recovery for months. Since she was then a temporary worker there, she feared she might have to pay for the huge amount of medication fee, she might lose her job and end up with nowhere to stay.

She then turned toward God and started praying and even speaking in tongues at her hospital room, where a nurse tried to stop her; however she ignored it and kept pressing on in spite of severe pains in her caused from the accident.

Shortly she became physically tired and fell into a sleep. When she woke up, she found her pains were gone and came to realize the Lord Almighty relieved her. Our God turned all to good, for she also received a whole year of wage as a compensation of injury from the company.

She said God had done so many great things on her, and she soon decided to focus her life on God instead in the world, saying 'God is in control of my life and now I am on the right track."

Ministry in Riverside Chapel's Outreach

-- New Jerusalem Church in the Philippines —

So many Philippines, including some non-Christians, were spiritually hungry for the Lord, received the Anointing of the Holy Spirit and dedicated their life to the work of their ministries, said pastor Marilyn, who last December with Pastor Nida Cabrera from Philippino Service and sister Michiko Yamauchi from Japanese Service evangelized at the outreach and Riverside's other churches in Quezon City of the Philippines.

Approximately 95% percent are catholic, some Buddhists and born-again Christians in the Philippines.

She said many manifestations of God's power took place in their outreach's ministries: such as children aged from three to 10 asked for blessings from God and also invited Christ in their hearts. A woman with the right side of the body paralyzed began to stand up and stamp her feet and praise God with joy in her heart, and shortly along with her husband invited Jesus in their lives on that day. A fever in a baby was relieved ...

The most impressive part of the ministries was around a hundred of Philippine children, most of them from nonChristian, needy families, some attending Jerusalem Christian Academy (JCA) founded by the church's pastor Benny Cabrera, attended the Special Christmas Event. Some have drawn their parents to know Jesus as their Savior.

'God can bring revival to the nation and encourage their faith and, the promise of God will come to pass. Whatever they put their hands to God will bless them', said Marilyn.

JCA, a non-profit Christian institute launched in the year of 2000, aims to educate children from needy families and to help them develop spiritually in a Christ-centered education. Since the institute is in its pioneering period, the institute lacks necessary funds to fulfill its aims and mission. 'God calls us to go out and preach the Good News because we carry the hope for the nations," said Marilyn, 'One little seed planted bear for multiple harvests."

Action Activates God's Power

The Bible says 'God gives us 'all things" by His Grace; we receive 'anything" because of our obedience of His commands; His divine power has given us "everything" by His glory and goodness." (2 Corinthians 9:8 NIV; 1 John 3:22; 2 Peter 1:3)

God wants to fulfill our wants, needs and desires, but why it does not work?

That is mainly because **faith** without action is dead, as a light in a room when we need we switch it on. But if we do not move ourselves forward to turn it on, there is no light.

Therefore if we know the Word of God and do not do it, all we have got is a devil faith because the devil knows every word in the Bible. But he does not act on God's Word, walk in love, in kindness, in forgiveness..., as James 2:19:20 states, "You believe that there is one God. Good! Even the demons believe that – and shudder. You foolish man, do you want evidence that faith without deeds is useless?"


