This is what the Lord has commanded: 'Each one is to gather as much as he needs. Take an omer for each person you have in your tent.' The Israelites did as they were told; some gathered much, some little. And when they measured it by the omer, he who gathered much did not have too much, and he who gathered little did not have too little. Each one gathered as much as he needed. Then Moses said to them, "No one is to keep any of it until morning. However, some of them paid no attention to Moses; they kept part of it until morning, but it was full of maggots and began to smell. So Moses was angry with them."

instead they were moving toward their dreams and making a difference in the world.

It is because David rested his confidence in the power of the living God he triumphed over the Philistine with a sling and a stone.

Do we know we are set in the heavenly place, in the high place with Christ? His covenant promises have been granted to us and He is our victory.

Let us take a closer examination at what attitudes the Israelites had in the desert and learn from the history as a mirror to our daily lives.

The Israelites 'murmure d'' in the wilderness, and Moses went to God each time they 'complained." Because God swore to their forefathers to give them the Promised Land flowing with milk and honey, He told Moses he would give them bread from heaven. They were instructed to take an omer each for the day they needed but they chose to 'ignore and disobey it." The following morning it bred worms and stank and Moses was angry because of their disobedience.

The Bible said that those who took more, there was nothing left over and those who went by the instruction because of the fear of the Lord lacked nothing.

Deut. 28:15-20 also tells us if we do not obey the voice of the Lord nor observe carefully all His commandments, curses and confusion will come upon us. So without realizing it is all due to our own disobedient acts we start to blame Satan and sometimes God. As a child of God, we should carefully notice that when we sin our consciousness condemns us and we feel restless. The other example of the cost of disobedience is even Moses himself could not get into the Promised Land because of the lack of self-control and endurance. (Continued on Page 3)

• Num. 20:7-12 shows 'The Lord said to Moses, 'Take the staff, and you and your brother Aaron gather the assembly together. Speak to the rock before their eyes and it will pour out its water. You will bring water out of the rock for the community so they and their livestock can drink. So Moses took the staff from the Lord's presence, just as He commanded him. He and Aaron gathered the assembly together in front of the rock and Moses said to them, 'Listen, you rebels, must we bring you water out of this rock?" Then Moses raised his arm and struck the rock twice with his staff. Water gushed out, and the community and their livestock drank. but the Lord said to Moses and Aaron, "Because you did not trust in Me enough to honor Me in the sight of the Israelites, you will not bring this community into the land I

Worship in the Greek language is 'proskuneo," 'pros" means 'face to face" and 'kuneo" 'kiss."

A true worshiper God desires is to have an intimacy with Him. Since God is Spirit in nature and Jesus Christ is the truth (John 14:6,) we must worship the Father in spirit and truth as well.

Before Jesus came to the earth in the flesh, there were no true worshipers existing. Israel's worship was just a shadow of the real substance for there was no faith in them. Meanwhile angelic beings' worship is based on the relationship between master and slave and they are not allowed to see the Lord God face to face so they worship God with a pair of their wings covering over their faces, as seraphim have six wings and cherubim have four wings.

Matt. 5:8 say, 'Blessed are the pure in heart, for they will see God." If we store up good things in our hearts, our words and actions will be good (Matt. 12:34) for our heart is the wellspring of life (Pro. 4:23.) Then we will see God and receive His salvation, deliverance and blessings.

One of the best true worshipers is shown in Matt. 26:6-13; Mark 14:3-9; John 12:1-8; Luke 7:36-

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Moses disobeyed God by 'striking" the rock with the rod twice instead of 'speaking" to it as the Lord commanded so it prevented Moses from entering the Promised Land. "Anger" can make us disobey God when we are offended and lose selfcontrol as Moses used his 'past experience" by striking the rock shown in Exodus 17:1-7.

So we should learn to rule over our emotions, and

48 concerning a sinful woman anointing Jesus with a jar of expensive perfume.

It said, 'The woman poured the perfume on Jesus' feet and wiped His feet with her hair. And the house was filled with the fragrance of the perfume (John 12:3)."

In those old days the perfume was used for a couple of reasons. One was for a bride to attract her bridegroom in her wedding night. The other was for the burial of a never-married woman. The alabaster jar of perfume was worth a year's wages of about 300 pence as expensive as a precious stone at that time.

But the perfume was nothing valuable to the woman Mary because of her former occupation as a prostitute. Though worshiping Jesus cost her financially, she had to pour out all her personal ambition and desires to worship Him and only through true worship the woman with an immorality problem received the revelation from God.

As for the disciples of Jesus, they only acknowledged worship as prostrate, face down like a master-slave relationship.

The depth of our worship is only part of our rela-

tionship with the Lord God, part of Jesus Christ in us, and His revelation in us is also part of our hunger and thirst for Him. **True Worship is not only singing holy songs to Him but also requires an intimacy with Him.**



to forgive and forget who has done wrong to us. When we obey God's instructions, we escape from the trap of temptation and receive good things God has in store for us. Dear Pastors, we are not clear about the definitions of 'Self -Denial," 'Humility" and 'Submission." Is self -denial sort humility? Or does self-denial mean submission?

No, in fact, self-denial, humility and submission are completely different three elements. Selfdenial is to give up things in order to follow Jesus. The Lord taught us that humility is meek and lowly in one's heart, but many thought the strength of self-condemnation is the secret of humility. Submission is to yield ourselves to God and accept His power. In other words, God is our top priority to everything and He demands total or absolute surrender where we become nothing. **With self-denial and humility comes the will to surrender**, a formula shown on the above.

Pastors, please give us some examples and scriptures related to this topic?

-- Self-denial means to sacrifice things like materials or pleasure in order to glorify the Lord. For example, gluttony is a common unobserved sin so fasting, the act of abstaining from food, can be method of self-denial. Things like giving up sleep or favorite things are also a method of fasting. For example, if one loves to eat chocolate, he or she always overeats them, then they can fast for a week or more not to eat chocolate.

Luke 9:23 (NIV) tells us **'Then He said to them** all: **'If anyone would come after Me, he must deny himself and take up his cross daily and follow Me.''** We deny ourselves for the sake of Him not of things we give up. Self-denial is not

-- Humility is perfect fruit of death to self. Jesus found His glory in taking the form of a servant as Matt. 23:11-12 said, "The greatest among you will be your servant. For whoever exalts himself will be humbled, and whoever humbles himself will be exalted."

The faithful servant who recognizes his position finds real pleasure in supplying the wishes of the master. James 4:10 tells us 'Humble yourselves before the Lord, and He will lift you up."

Humility often comes in the form of testing or discipline as in Deut 8:2 'Remember how the Lord your God led you all the way in the desert these forty years, **to humble you** and to test you in order to know what was in your heart, whether or not you would keep His commands."

-- Speaking of submission, God wants us to be all like Abraham who obeyed to sacrifice his only son Issac for everything he had came from God, so He has the right to take what is His. In James 4:7 said 'Submit yourselves, then, to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you." The story in 1 Kings 20:1-4 is also an example of submission concerning the king of Assyria sending messengers to the king of Israel Ahab for demanding surrender, and Ahab replied "My Lord all that I have are yours." By His grace He is willing to work it in us and not by our own accomplishes our surrender. strength, He (Compiled by: bro. Divine.)

But neither any rehab centers nor anyone could help me out of that addiction. The world of hallucination due to drugs effect became a way to relieve my hurt and frustration.

One day our merciful God had sister friend Naomi Ehigie came to invite me to their Jesus Women Prayer Ministry. As Evangelist Mrs. Eunice Osagiede came to deliver God's message, saying "Those who smoke in bed should stop, so as not to set the house on fire," which immediately tugged into my heart and brought me into a vision where I saw myself smoking in bed, then falling into a sleep, and the following morning I woke up and saw there was a cigarette burn hole in my pillow.

Since I, then a non-believer, could not recognize "It is our living true God speaking to me." Rather than appreciate Him for His mercy I turned to be mad at sister Naomi for I suspected she must have told the evangelist about my personal privacy and said to myself, "I won't go there again."

The suspicion and anger remained in me even after I went home. As usual I sat in my bed and lit up a cigarette. The message came fresh out of my mind, but I brushed it off saying, 'It doesn't matter!''I tried to remove the cig arette from my mouth, but I failed, and started to feel fear of God and immediately begged Him for forgiveness. Then I was able to remove it, and started to learn 'God has really given the message to the evangelist."

The following week I went back to the ministry for counseling. I was instructed to fast three days — the first day asking God for forgiveness, and the second day seeking God to help my needs for I wanted my husband back. Within those three days of fasting, our Mighty God came to reveal to me in my dream saying, "The promises in Jeremiah 31 are for you," but since that time I lacked the knowledge of the Word of God, I failed to find it out, and soon left it behind and went back to my old life.

Three years had passed since then. One day I suddenly became desperate in seeking God and went back to the ministry. The evangelist realized what happened to me and helped me rebuke and bind Satan the devil in Jesus' name, afterwards I was set free from drugs.

In 2000 I came to Japan and attended at Riverside Chapel where our unfailing-love God delivered me from both alcoholism and cigarettes. Last August I received a phone call from my nephew living in London. Surprisingly he said he had got in touch with my husband, who sought for a family reunion. So brethren I would like to encourage you, **'God answers my prayers and with Him all things are possible.'**
